Overview

Statkraft, thought to be Europe's largest producer of renewable energy, has commissioned Germany's largest solar battery storage hybrid power plant under the country's Renewable Energy Sources Act. The € 45 million plant was built on 41 hectares of a former gravel pit near the city.
