

High-altitude orbital solar power station



Overview

China has unveiled plans for a space power station at an altitude of 36,000 km, where sunlight is constant and 10 times more intense than on Earth. Apparently, it will be collecting energy around the clock and transmit it back to Earth. has fully launched the second stage of the Caipeng solar power plant (SPP) in the Tibet Autonomous Region in northwestern China. The second stage includes 170,000 photovoltaic panels with a total capacity of 100 MW located at an altitude of 5,228. A giant solar power station in space is to harvest unlimited solar energy without being affected by night and day nor seasons. However, China is currently making strides to turn this ambitious vision into reality, potentially revolutionizing our energy. The first phase of the Huaneng Nagu Photovoltaic Power Station, the world's highest-altitude solar power project, has been officially connected to the state grid in the Deqen Tibetan Autonomous Prefecture, Southwest China's Yunnan Province, at an altitude of over 5,240 meters, China Huaneng Group.
