Overview

Nigeria is carrying out feasibility study on Battery Energy Storage Systems, a project that will assess grid integration, identify viable business and regulatory models to attract investment, and build the capacity needed for ownership and sustainability. The two companies say their planned BESS assembly plant has the work of power generation and distribution facilities that connects the power sources to the end users. The African Development Bank (AfDB) has approved a \$1.2 million grant to support the development of a battery energy storage system (BESS) in Nigeria, a move seen as critical to stabilising the nation's power grid and accelerating renewable energy integration. Instead, it is being driven by a quieter but more consequential shift: the rise of decentralised, storage-backed power systems engineered for reliability, autonomy and economic.
