

Poland increased renewable energy penetration



Overview

For the first time in history, the share of energy produced from renewable sources exceeded 30% for the entire year. Although coal consumption has dropped, oil and gas use has risen and Poland remains the world's fourth highest emitting economy. 1 per cent of electricity, while coal and lignite plants produced 43.
