More than 17 gigawatts of new power capacity went online in the fourth quarter of 2024 and most (95%) of this capacity was renewable. Eighty-six percent of new capacity was from solar generation, with 12. 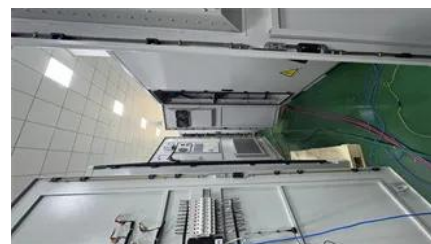
